As part of our class topic 'Hail Caesar' we will be taking year 3 children to find out more about Roman life by visiting the Lunt Fort in Coventry. The visit will take place on Wednesday 15th November. A bus will depart from school at 9.15am and will be returning to school at approximately 2.30pm.

The Lunt is an excellent example of an early Roman fort and is the only reconstructed Roman cavalry fort in Britain. Based on the archaeological evidence they have rebuilt a wooden gateway and ramparts have been reconstructed to create a glimpse into the history of Roman Britain.

During the day the children will have an interactive tour of the site, where they can climb the wooden ramparts to the gateway and visit the huge circular wooden gyrus. They will hear about the lives of soldiers at the fort and discover more about Roman armour and weapons. Finally they will be led by a uniformed commander to practise army drills, using swords and shields.

A voluntary contribution for the trip is £11.10 and can be made online via Parentpay. Unfortunately the trip can only take place upon receipt of the slip and payment by the due date. If you are having difficulty making this payment please talk to Mr Johnson in confidence. If we have insufficient response by the due date, we will have no alternative other than to cancel the trip.

As the majority of the day will be outdoors, the children will need to wear a school t-shirt and sweatshirt or cardigan, but they can wear trousers or leggings. They will also need sturdy footwear and a waterproof coat as well as a packed lunch, snack, and a disposable drink with them.

I'm sure you will agree this trip will be an informative and enjoyable day for all.
