Dear Parents/Carers

Summer has finally arrived and the weather is warming up!

As mentioned in previous newsletters I am writing to clarify the schools policy with regards to sun-cream. Can I please remind all parents/carers that we ask you to ensure that your child is sun safe when they arrive at school.

Please apply suncream (preferably a Sun Block or Factor 50) before school. Also ensure that your child has a water bottle, sun hat and plastic glasses (if required) in school for break and lunch times. By applying Sun Block or Factor 50 this should give up to 12 hours coverage and for the amount of time your child is outside this should be more than adequate. There is plenty of shade within the school grounds for children to sit or play.

We ask that the children DO NOT bring suncream into school. This is to protect all children as some are allergic to certain creams and as children like to share, we are unable to monitor their use.

However, should your child have a medical reason that requires more applications throughout the day, please contact school to discuss.

Thank you once again for your continued support in ensuring we keep all children safe.
