

#### Household Support Fund and free school meals

The objective of the Department for Work and Pensions' Household Support Fund grant is to support those most in need to help with global inflationary challenges and the significantly rising cost of living, in particular food, energy, and water bills.

Warwickshire County Council continues to be responsible for the administration of this grant for the county and is using a proportion of the funding to proactively support those families who are eligible for benefits related free school meals with a cost-of-living payment. This does not apply to children on the universal free school meal offer.

#### This funding finishes on the 31 March 2024.

Eligible families in Warwickshire will be sent an automatic cost of living payment in the form of Huggg supermarket vouchers in February, which will have a minimum value of £130 (£30 per eligible child for food support and £100 per eligible Warwickshire household for utilities support). For a parent/carer to be eligible for the £30 payment their child must be attending a Warwickshire maintained educational setting and for the household to be eligible to receive the £100 payment, they must be a resident of Warwickshire.


