Glossary

Vocabulary	Meaning
kingdom	A country or state ruled by a king or queen.
modern	Relating to the present.
empire	An extensive group of states governed by a single ruler.
archaeological	The scientific study of remains of a culture or people.
trade	The act of buying and selling goods.
Civil war	A war between citizens of the same country.
region	An area with definable characteristics but without fixed boundaries.
republic	A state with an elected president rather than a monarch.
economy	The state of a country or region in terms of goods they produce and consume.
biome	An area classified by the species that live there.
Biodiverse	The variety of life. When biodiversity is high, it means there are any different types of organisms and species

Blending	Mixing colours or tones in Art
Mood	Feeling created by the composition and colour of a piece of Art.
Reproduction	Copy of a piece of Art by an artist.
Palette	A particular range of colours used by an artist.
Tone	The degree of light or dark in a colour.
