Knowledge Building Blocks:

- People may show their belonging to an organised worldview through what they choose to wear.
- People may show their belonging to an organised worldview through the actions they choose to take.
- The 'Golden Rule' is a way of living that can be applied across many religious and non-religious worldviews.
- People can choose to express personal responsibility through different rituals, for example: worship, prayer and service.
- People's worldviews can influence the way they choose to live, leading to diverse lived expressions of both religious and non-religious worldviews.

Key Vocabulary:

Duty: A task or action that someone has to do.

Zakat: One of the five pillars of Islam. It is a form of giving.

Service: Helping others or doing work for someone.
