



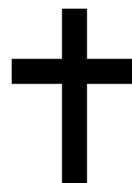

### Salvation

Why does Easter matter to Christians?

#### Knowledge Building Blocks:

- Easter is very important in the 'big story' of the Bible.
- Christians believe Jesus rose again, giving people hope of a new life.



#### Key Vocabulary:

Salvation: The saving of a person from sin or evil

Sin: Bad things people do which upset God

Forgive: No longer feel angry about a mistake

Crucifix: A representation of a cross with a figure of Christ on

Reunite: To come back together after being apart

#### Outcomes:

- Recognise that Incarnation and Salvation are part of a 'big story' of the Bible.
- Tell stories of Holy Week and Easter from the Bible
- and recognise a link with the idea of Salvation (Jesus rescuing people).
- Recognise that Jesus gives instructions about how to behave.
- Give at least three examples of how Christians show their beliefs about Jesus' death and resurrection in church worship at Easter.
- Think, talk and ask questions about whether the story of Easter has anything to say to them about sadness, hope or heaven, exploring different ideas.
