**CULMINGTON MANOR RESIDENTIAL TRIP:- MONDAY 9<sup>th</sup> – WEDNESDAY 11<sup>th</sup> JUNE 2025**

The time has almost arrived for our Year 6 Residential Trip to Culmington Manor. Please find details as follows to ensure the trip runs as smoothly as possible for all concerned. The coach will depart school at approximately 11.30am, Monday morning and will return to school around 4pm on Wednesday afternoon, depending upon traffic.

Please ensure that you arrive at school at the usual time. Parents will be asked to leave luggage in the hall. All children will then be gathered into the Year 6 classroom for registration and final important messages and checks. The children will need to bring with them everything they need to take onto the coach including their day bag and a named packed lunch box and drinks bottle which they will have on arrival. They will use these items throughout their stay. They will also need their coat/jacket. Please ensure your child has appropriate clothes and footwear to travel in: we may not be able to change clothes before our first activity.

In the morning Mrs Spence will collect any medication from you. All medication must be labelled, include instructions for use and be placed in a clear plastic bag with your child's name clearly written on it.

Please ensure you check the kit list you have received. Remember to pack old clothes and don't forget to include lots of socks too! Teddy is more than welcome to join the trip but must go straight to sleep when told!

- No mobile phones
- Bin liner for dirty clothes
- £5 limit for spending money (small change where possible)
- Don't forget bedding – including a pillow

I know the children will have a lovely time at Culmington Manor. Photographs will be uploaded to the Class 6 page of the website so do take a look in the evenings for a regular update from staff. The first post may not appear until Monday evening. Over the next few weeks, the children will be making a scrapbook of their time at Culmington Manor as a keepsake, which they will be able to share with you.

If you need to make contact, please ensure you contact the school directly in the first instance. For your information Mrs Wheeler and Mrs Spence will be accompanying myself for the duration of the trip.

Upon return, we will text you when the children set off from Culmington Manor and then text you again when they are 30 minutes away. Should you have any concerns please do not hesitate to get in touch.
