The Vikings



I'd like you to choose an activity – you may decide to do a different one each week, OR you may need to spend a few weeks if you've chosen something complicated!

There are no rules – you **can adapt any of the tasks** and present your homework **as a film, TV or newspaper report, a story, a poem, a painting, power point presentation, a 3D model, an instrument, baking etc.** The choice is yours - to be as creative as you can. You can either upload your work onto Google Classroom, or bring it into school. (For example – if you have baked something, you may prefer to eat your homework! Just remember to upload some pictures of your creation in the kitchen first.

Create a 3D model of a Viking longhouse. You could use a shoebox, junk modelling, lego or even Minecraft!	Create your own task to do with the Vikings!	Research and create a fact file about Viking invaders.
Draw or paint a picture of a Viking God or Goddess.	Write a song or rap about Vikings.	Create a model of a Viking longboat that can float.
Write your name in Ancient Runes and create a poster	Vikings had to be strong and fit. Create a Viking exercise regime and share it with a sibling, friend or relative.	Have a discussion with a friend or relative about the importance of learning about the past. Write a message in Viking runes.
Research a famous Viking or Norse God. Write a fact file or a poster.	Design a piece of Viking jewellery	Find out about Viking burials and draw a picture of what is important to you.
