Dear Parent/Guardian,

Apart from Universal Free School Meals which all children in Early Years Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1 are entitled to, families who receive certain benefits may also be eligible for substantial **Pupil Premium funding (FSM) of £1480**. Your child may be eligible for the additional funding if you're in receipt of one of the following benefits:

- Universal Credit
- Income Support
- Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance
- Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
- Support under Part 6 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guarantee element of Pension Credit
- Working Tax Credit run-on (paid for the four weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)
- Child Tax Credit (with no Working Tax Credit)

By registering for this it will bring in an additional £1480 for 6 consecutive years to the school which we are able to fund valuable support like extra tuition, additional teaching staff or pay for after school activities, wrap around care and help to buy uniform etc.

This additional money is available from central government for every child whose parent is receiving one of the benefits listed above.
