Key Vocabulary:

Philosophy: looks at where knowledge comes from, ideas and the possible answers to big questions.

Nones: People who are not religious.

Knowledge Building Blocks:

- Philosophy is one of the disciplines that can be used to study religion and worldviews. The other main ones are theology (sacred texts and beliefs) and human & social sciences (lived expressions of worldviews).
- There are more non-religious people living in the UK now than ever before. These are sometimes called 'Nones' and there can be different types: spiritual, campaigning and tolerant.
- Those with religious worldviews often turn to sacred texts for guidance. For example: Bible (Christian worldviews), Torah (Jewish worldviews), Qur'an (Muslim worldviews)
- The same story can be expressed differently in different sacred texts, such as the story of Noah/Nuh in Abrahamic worldviews as told in the Old Testament (Bible) Torah and the Qur'an.
