Vocabulary

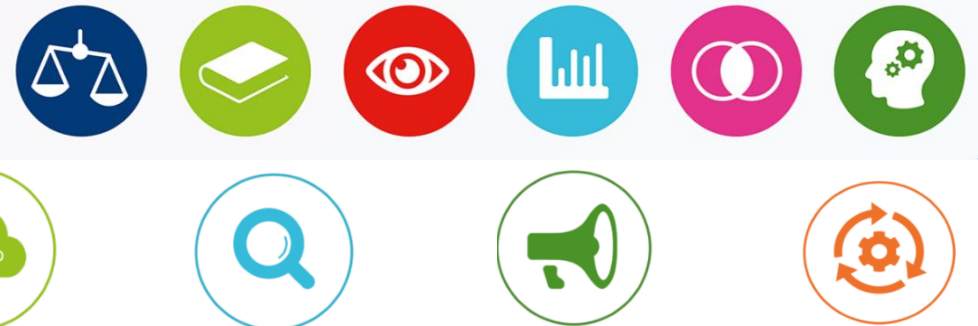
Spring- Weather starts to get warmer
Summer- Warmest time of the year
Autumn- temperature starts to get colder
Winter- the coldest time of the year
Sunrise - the time in the morning when the sun appears or full daylight arrives
Sunset - the time in the evening when the sun disappears or daylight fades

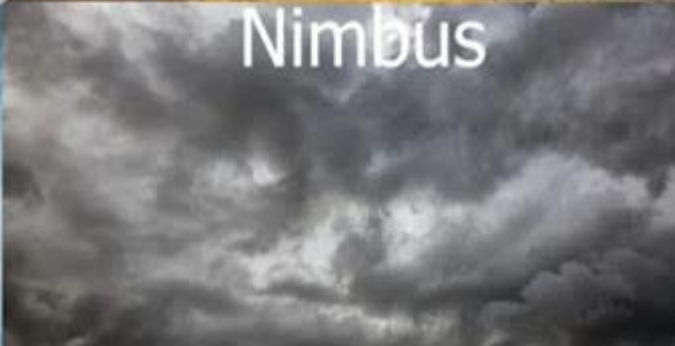
Spring

- March, April and May.
- Weather is warmer.
- Season of new beginnings.
- Fresh buds bloom, animals awoken. Farmers plant seeds.
- Approx. 12 hours daylight.

Summer

- June, July and August.
- The weather is much warmer.
- Warmest season of the year.
- Lots of leaves on trees.
- Approx. 16 hours of daylight





Clouds are formed when water in the air cools down and changes from a gas called water vapour into droplets of liquid water - or even tiny ice crystals. This process is called condensation.

- The sun is a star
- It is a hot ball of glowing gas.
- At the heart of the solar system
- It is spherical in shape and much bigger than Earth- 1,350,000 times bigger!
- The temperature at the sun's core is about 27 million degrees Fahrenheit.
