Cliff	A steep rockface by the edge of the sea
Ocean	A huge body of salt water that covers most of the Earth.
Seashell	The external skeletons of some sea animals.
Map	An aerial view of an area, marking the human and physical geography.
Ship	A large sailing vessel.
Treasure	Precious metals or gems.
Pirate	A person who attacks and robs ships at sea.
