Historical Knowledge (summer 1)

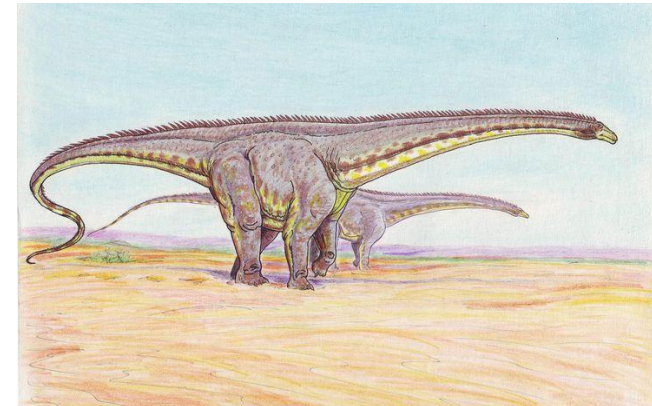
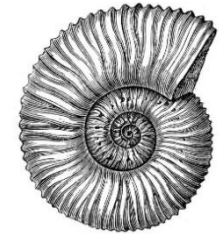
- Find out what life was like in Georgian England and what people knew about dinosaurs at the time.
