HOME LEARNING EXPECTATIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please read with your child each day wherever possible. • Please remember to write your comments in the Reading Record Book provided. • Homework should be complete on time to avoid unnecessary upset. • Please ensure that homework presentation is to a good standard.
HOW TO SUPPORT YOUR CHILD AT HOME	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Praise your child and share an interest in what they are doing. • Recognise their achievements and celebrate them. • Ensure they undertake any home learning in a calm environment at a suitable time. • Ask questions to probe thought and recognise their own errors or misconceptions. • Ensure they have the right tools to do the job. • Take a break if required – do not spend more than the recommended time. • If it is proving too difficult, acknowledge that and write a note on it for the teacher. • <i>The most effective home learning is based on conversation about the world around them.</i>
INFORMATION TO REMEMBER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PE KITS – Children need to come into school wearing their PE kit on Wednesdays and Thursdays. • UNIFORM should be appropriate and suitable for all weather conditions. • WATER BOTTLES provided daily. • WELLIES and waterproofs for outdoor learning (to be kept in school). • NEWSLETTERS contain a wealth of current information. These are uploaded to google classroom on Fridays.
