#### Key vocabulary

Big Idea: significant people and events

Big Question: Why is Queen Victoria known as one of the most famous monarchs in British History?

#### Historical Knowledge (summer 1)

- To find out about the life of Queen Victoria.
- To find out what the Industrial revolution was and how it affected Britain.
- To find out about important inventions of the Victorian era.
- To find out about health, disease and medicine in Victorian Britain.
- To find out what the Victorians did during their leisure time.

#### Geographical Knowledge (summer 2)

- To find out which countries were part of the British Empire and locate them on a world map.

#### Art Knowledge

- To find out about Victorian decoupage and use the method to create a piece of art work.
- To explore the artwork of William Morris and the Arts and crafts movement. (Artist study)
- To create a sketch portrait of Queen Victoria from imagination based on what they have learnt from sketching and painting.
- To explore the use of Victorian samplers and use cross stitch to sew a simple design.

colonialism	The practice of acquiring full control over another country or people.
empire	An extensive group of states or countries ruled over by a single leader.
Industrial Revolution	1760-1840. A change from handicraft to industrial manufacturing.
population	The inhabitants of a particular place.
reign	The period of rule of a monarch.
Victorian	Relating to the reign of Queen Victoria.
