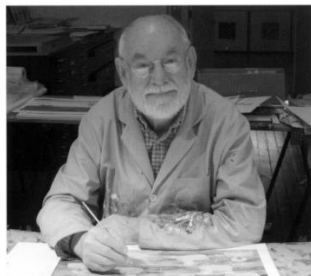

Glossary

Hibernate 	When animals sleep through the winter months.
Nocturnal 	Animals that sleep during the day but are awake and feed at night.
Life cycle 	How an animal or insect changes and grows.
Egg 	Oval or round object, usually containing a baby animal.
Chrysalis 	A hard, protective shell that a caterpillar builds around itself while it changes into an adult butterfly.
Butterfly 	An insect with wings that are usually brightly coloured.
Caterpillar 	The young of butterflies or moths.
Mammal 	An animal that breathes air, has a backbone, and grows hair at some point during its life.
Bird 	An animal with two wings, two feet, and a body covered with feathers.
Reptile 	An animal that has scales and is cold blooded.
Habitat 	The home of an animal or plant.
