Vocabulary	Meaning
chronological	arranged in the order that events actually happened in time, starting with the earliest and moving forward
exploration	the act of traveling through an unfamiliar area, or carefully examining something to learn more about
mission	an important task or assignment given to a person or group, often involving travel or a specific goal

significant	important, notable, or large enough to be noticed, and it can also mean conveying a specific or hidden meaning
sources	the place, person, or thing where something begins, comes from, or is obtained.
