<p>Prime Area of Learning Personal, Social and Emotional Development</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • What makes me special/ my special people • Who can help me? • Feelings • self-care and self-regulation techniques • Developing relationships • Class rules: Behavioural expectations in the class/boundaries set • How can we be healthy? 	<p>Specific Area of Learning Literacy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Listen and enjoy sharing and joining in with a wide range of books, poems and songs. • Phonics - start to learn to read and write phase 2 sounds. • Develop listening and speaking skills in a range of contexts. • Give meaning to marks they make. Understand that thoughts can be written down. • Start to blend known sounds to read simple regular words e.g. mum, dad. • Write their name with a name card or try to write it from memory.
<p>Prime Area of Learning Communication and Language</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Talking about family/ routines and special occasions. • Following instructions in routines. • Developing listening skills and phonological awareness. • Developing social phrases e.g. 'good morning!' • Asking why. • Engaging in story times. 	<p>Specific Area of Learning Mathematics</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Getting to know you • Matching • Sorting • Comparing amounts • Comparing length, weight and capacity. <p>Specific Area of Learning Understanding the World</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Talk about members of their immediate family and the relationship to them, name and describe people who are familiar to them. • Begin to develop a sense of continuity and change by being able to compare characters from stories. • Learn about themselves and special things in their own lives. • Explore the natural world. • Comment on images of familiar situations in the past.
<p>Prime Area of Learning Physical Development</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Develop confidence and movement skills using apparatus and space outdoors. • Develop and refine fine motor skills and hand eye coordination needed for writing. • Develop a good pencil grip • Use a range of tools to develop small motor skills. • Make healthy choices about food, drink, activity and toothbrushing. 	<p>Specific Area of Learning Expressive Arts and Design</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Explore, use and refine a variety of artistic effects to express their ideas and feelings • Sing in a group or on their own, increasingly matching the pitch and following the melody. • Create collaboratively, sharing ideas, resources and skills. • Develop storylines in their pretend play.
