To refine a procedure using repeat commands to improve a program. To be able to use a variable to increase programming possibilities. To change an input to a program to achieve a different output. To use logical reasoning to detect and debug mistakes in a program.
Spring 2	Handling Data	To be able to use a spreadsheet and database to collect and record data. (Excel.) To choose an appropriate tool to help me collect data. (Purple Mash, Excel.) To present data in an appropriate way independently. To be able to search a database using different operators to refine my search. To talk about mistakes in data and suggest how it could be checked.

Summer 1	Multimedia	To be able to use text, photo, sound and video editing tools to refine my work. (iMovie's.) To be able to use the skills I have already developed to create content using unfamiliar technology. To be able to select, use and combine the appropriate
