### Meaning

Ancient

A long time ago, a period in the past or something very old.

Century

A period of 100 years.

Decade

A period of 10 years.

Kirtle

A woman's loose gown, worn in the Middle Ages.

Ruff

A neckpiece or collar worn in Tudor's times.

Scythe

An agricultural implement consisting of a long, curving blade fastened at an angle to a handle, for cutting grass, grain, etc., by hand.

Gown

A woman's dress or robe, especially one that is full-length.

Corset

A close-fitting undergarment, capable of being tightened by lacing and worn, especially by women, to shape and support the body;

Heir

A person who inherits or has a right of inheritance in the property of another following their death.

Reign

The period during which a king or Queen occupies the throne.

monarch

A king, Queen or Emperor or someone who rules a nation.
