Specific Area of Learning Literacy Listen and enjoy sharing and joining in with a wide range of books, poems and songs. Phonics - start to learn to read and write phase 2 sounds. Develop listening and speaking skills in a range of contexts. Give meaning to marks they make. Understand that thoughts can be written down. Start to blend known sounds to read simple regular words e.g. mum, dad. Write their name with a name card or try to write it from memory. Specific Area of Learning 	
	Mathematics Getting to know you Matching Sorting Comparing amounts Comparing length, weight and capacity. 	
 Prime Area of Learning Communication and Language Talking about family/ routines and special occasions. Following instructions in routines. Developing listening skills and phonological awareness. Developing social phrases e.g. 'good morning!' Asking why. Engaging in story times. 	 Specific Area of Learning Understanding the World Talk about members of their immediate family and the relationship to them, name and describe people who are familiar to them. Begin to develop a sense of continuity and change by being able to compare characters from stories. Learn about themselves and special things in their own lives. Explore the natural world. Comment on images of familiar situations in the past. 	
 Prime Area of Learning Physical Development Develop confidence and movement skills using apparatus and space outdoors. Develop and refine fine motor skills and hand eye coordination needed for writing. Develop a good pencil grip Use a range of tools to develop small motor skills. Make healthy choices about food, drink, activity and toothbrushing. 	 Specific Area of Learning Expressive Arts and Design Explore, use and refine a variety of artistic effects to express their ideas and feelings Sing in a group or on their own, increasingly matching the pitch and following the melody. Create collaboratively, sharing ideas, resources and skills. Develop storylines in their pretend play.
