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<p>INFORMATION TO REMEMBER</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • UNIFORM should be labelled, appropriate and suitable for all weather conditions. Wellies to be kept in school. • LABELLED WATER BOTTLES brought into school each day with fresh water (not squash). • BOOK BAGS to be checked daily for messages or letters. • FOREST SCHOOL will be on Mondays, beginning Monday 18th September. Children need to come to school wearing forest school clothes - blue or white long sleeved clothing and blue leggings/joggers and trainers. Arms and legs must be covered. If it is a very hot day, blue shorts and a white or blue t-shirt can be sent in their bag to change into when not at forest school. If it is very cold, please send in extra layers.
