The children will have a login stuck in their reading diaries. • Reading Group A – Books changed on Monday and Thursday Group B – Books changed on Tuesday and Friday • spag.com – This is a website which provides the children with punctuation and grammar activities. As with mathematics, activities will be uploaded every week. Passwords will be sent to you.
HOME LEARNING EXPECTATIONS	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Read at home, little and often is the best motto. The children need to read to an adult daily where ever possible. • Please remember to write your comments in the Reading Record Book provided. • Homework should be handed in on time to avoid unnecessary upset. • Please ensure that homework presentation is to a good standard.
HOW TO SUPPORT YOUR CHILD AT HOME	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Praise your child and share an interest in what they are doing. • Read to your child to develop their vocabulary. • Recognise their achievements and celebrate them. • Ensure they undertake any home learning in a calm environment at a suitable time. • Ask questions to probe thought and recognise their own errors or misconceptions. • Ensure they have the right tools to do the job. • Take a break if required – do not spend more than the recommended time. • If it is proving too difficult, acknowledge that and write a note on it for the teacher. • <i>The most effective home learning is based on conversation about the world around them.</i>
INFORMATION TO REMEMBER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PE KITS must be worn for PE on Wednesdays and Fridays. • UNIFORM should be appropriate and suitable for all weather conditions. • WATER BOTTLES provided daily. • WELLIES and waterproofs for outdoor learning (to be kept in school). • NEWSLETTERS contain a wealth of current information (on google classroom).
