Vocabulary	Meaning
Crimea	Crimea is a peninsula located on the northern coast of the Black Sea in Eastern Europe.
Crimean War	The Crimean War was a military conflict fought from October 1853 to February 1856.
Doctor	A person who is qualified to treat someone who is ill.
Famous	Known about by many people.
Hospital	An institution providing medical and surgical treatment and nursing care for sick or injured people.
Medical	Relating to the science or practice of medicine.
Nightingale pledge	A pledge recited by nurse's to indicate their commitment to their patient's care.
Nurse	A person trained to take care of the sick or injured.
Scutari	The location of the British army hospital where Florence Nightingale worked.
Victorian	A person who lived during the reign of Queen Victoria.
