How to keep safe at home, indoors and outdoors To talk about keeping safe, safe touches and consent Keeping safe online To name the people in their lives who keep them safe	Literacy Read some letter groups that each represent one sound and say sounds for them (ow,ee,ur,ai,or). Blend sounds into words when reading. Segment/spell words by identifying the sounds when writing. Read a few common exception words (going,have,do,so). Form lower-case and capital letters correctly. Read simple phrases and sentences. Write simple sentences. Re-read books to build confidence, fluency and understanding.
Communication and Language Can switch attention from one task to another. Follow complex instructions. Respond to discussion with comments and questions. To listen in whole school Collective Worship and recall some of the themes and comments at a later stage. Enjoy being part of conversations and discussions and use new vocabulary in context. Use talk in different ways, in imaginative play, to develop thinking, to collaborate and plan with others and to express ideas. 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INFORMATION TO REMEMBER	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • UNIFORM should be labelled, appropriate and suitable for all weather conditions. Wellies to be kept in school. • LABELLED WATER BOTTLES brought into school each day with fresh water (not squash). • BOOK BAGS to be checked daily for messages or letters. • FOREST SCHOOL will restart after February half term on Monday 19th February. Children need to come to school wearing forest school clothes (long sleeved clothing and blue leggings/joggers) and trainers. • PE will be on Mondays (until Forest School restarts) and Thursdays. Children need to come to school wearing their PE kit (blue T-shirt, blue leggings/joggers/skort/shorts) and trainers.
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
