| Vocabulary | Meaning |
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| kingdom | A country or state ruled by a king or queen. |
| modern | Relating to the present. |
| empire | An extensive group of states governed by a single ruler. |
| archaeological | The scientific study of remains of a culture or people. |
| trade | The act of buying and selling goods. |
| Civil war | A war between citizens of the same country. |
| region | An area with definable characteristics but without fixed boundaries. |
| republic | A state with an elected president rather than a monarch. |
| economy | The state of a country or region in terms of goods they produce and consume. |
| biome | An area classified by the species that live there. |
| biodiverse | The variety of life. When biodiversity is high, it means there are any different types of organisms and species. |
