



Seasons	4 parts of the year which have different weather and times of light.	
Spring	New plants begin to grow and the weather gets warmer.	
Petals	Usually bright colours at the top of the plant.	
Stem	To help the plant stand up.	
Roots	To get water and nutrients.	
Seed	A part of a plant that can grow into a new plant.	
Easter	Celebrating Jesus's resurrection.	
Forgive	To no longer feel angry or upset about something someone has done.	
Lent	40 days before Easter.
